Prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health (physical and mental) by managing the health and safety risks in the workplace	Dominic Chandler	Continuously monitor the working environment to improve and adapt our health and safety policies. Provide full PPE to all crew and staff including steel toe cap boots, high visibility clothing & protective gloves.
Provide clear instructions and information, and adequate training, to ensure employees are competent to do their work	Dominic Chandler	Provide adequate training prior to arriving on-site with further on-site health & safety coverage adapted to each environment. Machinery training will be provided to those who require it.
Implement emergency procedures – evacuation in case of fire or other significant incident.	Dominic Chandler	Go through fire evacuation procedures based on the venue or site regulations with all crew & staff. Work with the venue or on-site fire marshals to ensure safe practices during any incident are kept to standard.
Maintain safe and healthy working conditions, provide and maintain plant, equipment and machinery, and ensure safe storage/use of substances	Dominic Chandler	Toilets, washing facilities and drinking water provided. System in place for routine inspections and testing of equipment and machinery and ensuring that action is promptly taken to address any defects.

<p>Electrocution</p>	<p>Crew, other vendors & members of the public could be injured by electrocution as a result of failure of electrocution safety negligence.</p>	<p>Equipment is inspected thoroughly prior to being picked for any event, plus yearly, if not every 6 monthly PAT testing & inspection.</p>	<p>Crew to briefly inspect once picked for use. Ensure safe electrical practices are used during the build of an electrical system. Ensure all and any equipment not rated to the correct IP standard for that All crew, On-site project manager & crew chief. environment is changed</p>	<p>All crew, On-site project manager & crew chief</p>
